OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES LICENSING BOARD

SPECIAL MEETING

October 20, 2000

A special meeting of the Outfitters and Guides Licensing Board was called to order at 9:00 AM, Friday, October 20, 2000 in the Boardroom, 1365 North Orchard, Rm 172, Boise Idaho. Board Chairman Wayne Hunsucker and member Ray Lyon were present at the Board office. Members Scott Farr and Bill Bernt were available by telephone conference. Also in attendance were Executive Director Dean Sangrey and Board Counsel Steve Scanlin.

The purpose of the meeting was to review comments submitted concerning the Board's rules amendment package and legislative proposals for final Board action. Mr. Scanlin reviewed the proposed changes to the rule package by line item. Following this discussion, MSC (Lyon-Bernt) TO ADOPT THE PROPOSED RULES AMENDMENT PACKAGE AS PRESENTED.

Mr. Scanlin then proceeded to review the content of the Licensing Board legislative amendment package that includes licensing of wagon and sleigh rides, upgrade enforcement supervisor position to police officer status at PERSI, adjust the definition of what constitutes a license year, move a portion of Sec. 36-2107 to a IDFG title and chapter, modify the definition of outfitter and guide, and change the definition of license year. A discussion ensued regarding the question of adding wagon and sleigh rides as licensable activities. Several individuals have expressed concerns about excessive regulation in this area and the Governor's office is not supportive of the proposal at this time. Mr. Scanlin also advised that as a result of recent discussions with legal counsel from the IDFG, the proposal to shift that reference in IOGLB statute to F&G doesn't need to be pursued as they will be deleting it from their code anyway. At the conclusion of these discussions, MSC (Lyon-Bernt) TO DELETE THE PROPOSAL FOR LICENSING WAGON AND SLEIGH RIDE ACTIVITIES AND WORK WITH COUNSEL FROM IDFG TO ELIMINATE THE IRRELEVANT PORTION OF THE STATUTE.
