



OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES LICENSING BOARD**

**Special Board Meeting  
January 25, 2001**

A special teleconference Board meeting was called to order at 9:15 AM, Thursday, January 25, 2001, with Board Chairman Wayne Hunsucker, and members Ray Lyon, Bill Bernt, Scott Farr, and Will Judge, Executive Director Dean Sangrey and Board Counsel Steve Scanlin, present.

**East Moose Creek Vacated Outfitter Operating Area:** Director Sangrey reviewed the final copy of the Decision Memo (DM) issued by Joe Hudson, District Ranger for the Moose Creek Ranger District addressing the East Moose Creek vacated outfitter operating area. Copies had earlier been provided to the Board members for their review. The decision documents the recommendation from the Forest Service that the existing operating area boundaries for the four neighboring outfitters, 62 Ridge Outfitters, Quarter Circle "A", Lost Lakes Outfitters, and Boulder Creek Outfitters, be realigned to incorporate portions of the former East Moose Creek outfitted area. The decision further documents the establishment of three assigned outfitter camps within the re-apportioned East Moose area, and recognizes the determination to divide the available allocated elk tags between the existing licensees and retaining some for distribution in hardship cases. The Board is in general agreement with the decision as rendered by Ranger Hudson, although they continue to have some reservations about the needs assessment determination that only 20% of the identified total of 1,500 user days in the vacated area are available for outfitted client use. Following this review and discussion, MSC (Farr-Hunsucker) TO ACCEPT THE DECISION MEMO FOR THE EAST MOOSE CREEK VACATED OUTFITTER AREA ISSUED BY MR. JOE HUDSON, DISTRICT RANGER FOR THE MOOSE CREEK RANGER DISTRICT. THE DECISION PROVIDES THAT 1) THE OPERATING AREAS FOR FOUR ADJOINING OUTFITTERS, 62 RIDGE OUTFITTERS, QUARTER CIRCLE "A", LOST LAKES OUTFITTERS, AND BOULDER CREEK OUTFITTERS, BE REALIGNED TO INCORPORATE DIFFERENT PORTIONS OF THE FORMER EAST MOOSE CREEK OUTFITTED AREA; 2) THREE ASSIGNED OUTFITTER CAMPS WILL BE ESTABLISHED IN THE REAPPORTIONED EAST MOOSE AREA, AND 3) THE DETERMINATION TO DIVIDE THE AVAILABLE ALLOCATED ELK TAGS BETWEEN THE EXISTING LICENSEES WHILE RETAINING SOME FOR DISTRIBUTION IN HARDSHIP CASES WITHIN THE ZONE. THE DIRECTOR IS FURTHER INSTRUCTED TO INFORM THE DISTRICT RANGER THAT THE IOGLB INTENDS TO CONTINUE ITS DIALOGUE WITH THE DISTRICT REGARDING THE DETERMINATION THAT 20% OF THE USER DAYS BE AVAILABLE FOR OUTFITTED CLIENTS.
