

**THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE IDAHO OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES LICENSING BOARD WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 9:05 A.M. APRIL 6, 2011, AT THE IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME, 600 S. WALNUT, BOISE, IDAHO. MEMBERS WAYNE HUNSUCKER (CHAIRMAN), ALEX IRBY AND CHRIS KORELL WERE IN ATTENDANCE. ALSO PRESENT WERE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR JAKE HOWARD, VIRGIL MOORE, LANCE HEBDON, BRAD COMPTON WITH MFG AND GRANT SIMONDS WITH THE IOGA. STEVE SCHMIDT AND JOHN HANSEN, IDFG PARTICIPATED VIA VIDEO CONFERENCE.**

**Capacity Work Session Analysis Processes: Outfitted Hunting on Private Land —** Director Howard gave a brief overview of history of the matter including an overview of the matters surfacing at the November Board meeting, the legal consideration of imposing limits, how this process parallels pending decisions involving outfitted turkey and waterfowl hunting and the need to update or revise the MOU between the Board and IDFG and draft policies regarding capacity analysis processes involving outfitted hunting on private land. IDFG presented their analysis of overall outfitter/non-outfitter harvest success rates for deer and elk on private land verses public lands statewide. The group then discussed primary concerns with "front zone hunts with high access" is the greatest concern. Director Howard asked whether this concept was defined or designated in any way. Grant Simonds and IDFG discussed they thought it had been with earlier elk controlled hunt designation in the hunting regulations. The group discussed the LAP tag process with respect to Board decision regarding establishing appropriate limits for outfitted hunting on private lands. Chris Korell suggested developing a cap formula based on a slide scale with harvest and percentages of private verse public land. The group discussed IDFG providing scenarios based on several units statewide including 36, 36a, 37, 39 and the Tex Creek zone. They discussed Director Howard meeting with IDFG and possibly of another group meeting prior to a presentation at the May Board meeting.
