FINAL CONFERENCE CALL MINUTES

August 5, 2011

A SPECIAL CONFERENCE CALL OF THE IDAHO OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES LICENSING BOARD WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 9:35 A.M. AUGUST 5, 2011 IN THE MEETING ROOM, AT THE IDAHO OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES LICENSING BOARD OFFICE, 1365 N. ORCHARD BOISE, IDAHO. MEMBERS WAYNE HUNSUCKER (CHAIRMAN), TOM LONG AND ALEX IRBY ALL PARTICIPATED BY CONFERENCE CALL. ALSO PRESENT WERE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR JAKE HOWARD, BOARD SECRETARY LORI THOMASON, EDUCATION AND ENFORCEMENT CHIEF RANDY WADLEY, ROGER HALES BOARD ATTORNEY. CHRIS KORELL AND LOUISE STARK WERE NOT PRESENT AT THE MEETING

One-time Controlled Hunt Request Conflict in Unit 36-B - Director Howard provided a brief overview to the Board of the matters involving White Cloud Outfitters, Mike Scott and Mile High Outfitters, Travis Bullock concerning conflicting one-time controlled sheep hunt requests in Unit 36-B. Director Howard provided written information submitted by each outfitter and Board member Korell. Grant Simonds, Executive Director for IOGA joined the meeting and was recognized.

MSC (MOTION, LONG; SECOND, IRBY — AYES HUNSUCKER; NAPES -- NONE) TO APPROVE GRANTING TRAVIS BULLOCK, MILE HIGH OUTFITTERS REQUEST TO HUNT SHEEP IN JOHN CRANNEY'S LICENSED AREA AND MILE HIGH OUTFITTER'S OWN LICENSED AREA AS REQUESTED AND TO DENY MIKE SCOTT, WHITE CLOUD OUTFITTER'S REQUEST TO HUNT SHEEP IN MILE HIGH OUTFITTERS LICENSED AREA AND IN JOHN CRANNEY'S LICENSED AREA AS REQUESTED. THE BOARD ENCOURAGES MR. SCOTT AND MR. BULLOCK TO WORK TOGETHER TO ACCOMMODATE WHITE CLOUD OUTFITTERS' SHEEP HUNTER THIS YEAR. THE BOARD ASKED DIRECTOR HOWARD TO SCHEDULE OTHER RELATED MATTERS ON ONETIME CONTROLLED HUNTS FOR THE AUGUST MEETING.

Shane Reynolds - Director Howard explained that ROW Outfitter's asked the Board to allow Mr. Shane Reynolds to amend his guide license to work for ROW as a river guide. He also explained that at the May Board meeting Mr. Reynolds had been placed on

restricted probation and where he needed the Board authorization to amend his license each time he wanted to work for another outfitter while on probation.

MSC (MOTION, IRBY; SECOND, LONG — AYES HUNSUCKER, IRBY, LONG; NAYES -- NONE) AMEND SHANE REYNOLDS' GUIDE LICENSE TO WORK FOR ROW OUTFITTERS.

Wescout4u.Com, **Outfitters Robbie Denning** - Director Howard mentioned that Robbie Denning had brought to his attention that it appeared the deer hunting client numbers authorized by the Board at their June hearing were incorrect in the information that Mr. Denning had received. The Director said that after reviewing the information discussed with the Board at their May meeting, it appears the minutes and the order provided to Mr. Denning were incorrect regarding the calculated number of buck deer hunting clients for the 2011 hunting season. He said the number should be 16 clients authorized to hunt buck deer for upcoming 2011 hunting season only. He mentioned that authorization for elk and deer clients numbers would be set for future years after the conclusion of each hunting season.

MSC (MOTION, LONG; SECOND, IRBY — AYES HUNSUCKER, LONG, IRBY; NAYES NONE) TO CORRECT THE ERROR IN THE MOTION AND ORDER FROM THE JUNE 2011 HEARING IDENTIFYING THE NUMBER OF BUCK DEER HUNTING CLIENTS FOR THE 2011 HUNTING SEASON AUTHORIZED TO WESCOUT4U.COM OUTFITTERS TO BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CAPACITY ANALYSIS RECOMMENATION OF 16 CLIENTS AUTHORIZED TO HUNT BUCK DEER FOR UPCOMING 2011 HUNTING SEASON.

With no further business to come before the Board, Chairman Hunsucker adjourned the meeting at 10:00 a.m., Friday August 5, 2011.
